Here are **two grants** to support your students' creativity and their ability to transform an **idea into action!**

Each West-Island public high school is eligible for one of the two grants.

1. The Créneau Carrefour Volunteering Grant

The Quebec Government will finance via the Carrefour a maximum of \$1000 per public high school in the West Island to support Volunteer projects developed by students for their community, for a cause, or for their school! (4 schools)

Volunteering is characterized by the following:

- unpaid and freely chosen involvement
- Students support a cause by offering their time, knowledge and skills
- The project fosters social engagement and helps develop a youth's sense of belonging to the community.

2. The Carrefour jeunesse-emploi Entrepreneurship Grant

Carrefour jeunesse-emploi de l'Ouest-de-l'Île will finance a maximum of \$1000 per public high school in the West Island to support Entrepreneurial projects developed by students. (8 schools)

An entrepreneurial project is defined as:

- creating a product, service or event to satisfy a need or demand in the community
- finding a solution to a problem
- improving a situation for a target audience that goes beyond the project participants themselves

Your project should be in line with Quebec's Youth Strategy and fit into one or more of the following categories.

- Healthy lifestyles
- A school environment that supports staying in school and academic perseverance
- Engaging youth in culture, community initiatives, society and the environment
- Preparing youth for work and preparing the economy to welcome them!
- Supporting entrepreneurship skills and abilities

What do you get?

- Up to \$1000 to support your project
- Individual assistance from a Project Manager at Carrefour jeunesse-emploi if needed
- Free showcasing of your project at www.canadaprojects.ca
- Free Registration to www.321incubator.com
This project-development workshop can help you to structure and/or brainstorm project ideas with your students.

The \$1000 can be split to support more than one project from each school.

- Proof of payment for the expenses
- Photos and/or videos of your students engaged in the project that will be posted at www.canadaprojects.ca and on the Carrefour's social media outlets.
- Number of boys and girls that participate in the project's development and their grade levels
